Squirrels

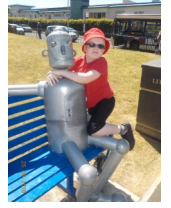


Squirrels have been enjoying horse riding and a fun trip to the Beach this half term

Everyone had a fabulous day.

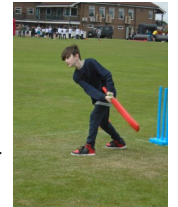


Sports Week
