This short report summarises how 2016/17 funding was spent. Most importantly, it provides information on the outcomes of the spending and the improvements made amongst our pupils.

Spending of the Year 7 Catch-Up Premium 2016-17

The Academy continued to support year 7 pupils in a wide range of interventions that supported progress and maximised opportunities. Due to the needs of the pupils the grant has been used for specific literacy and numeracy resourcing as well as interventions that allow pupils to access these parts of the curriculum. These interventions have included for extra specialist staff to allow for pupils to access the following:

- Individualised Communication sessions incorporating the pupils SCERTS targets
- Lego groups
- Emotional Regulation programmes including Zones of Regulation
- Use of the 'Clicker 7' programme

Outcome of the spending of Year 7 Catch Up Premium 2016-17

- A range of offsite education activities, e.g. shopping, travel, with additional staff support these activities
- Clicker 7 installed in every classrooms. All pupils have access to this for writing.
- Use of SCERTS for some pupils with staff trained and SCERTS guidelines published
- Pastoral Manager delivered lego group training and monitored these interventions.
