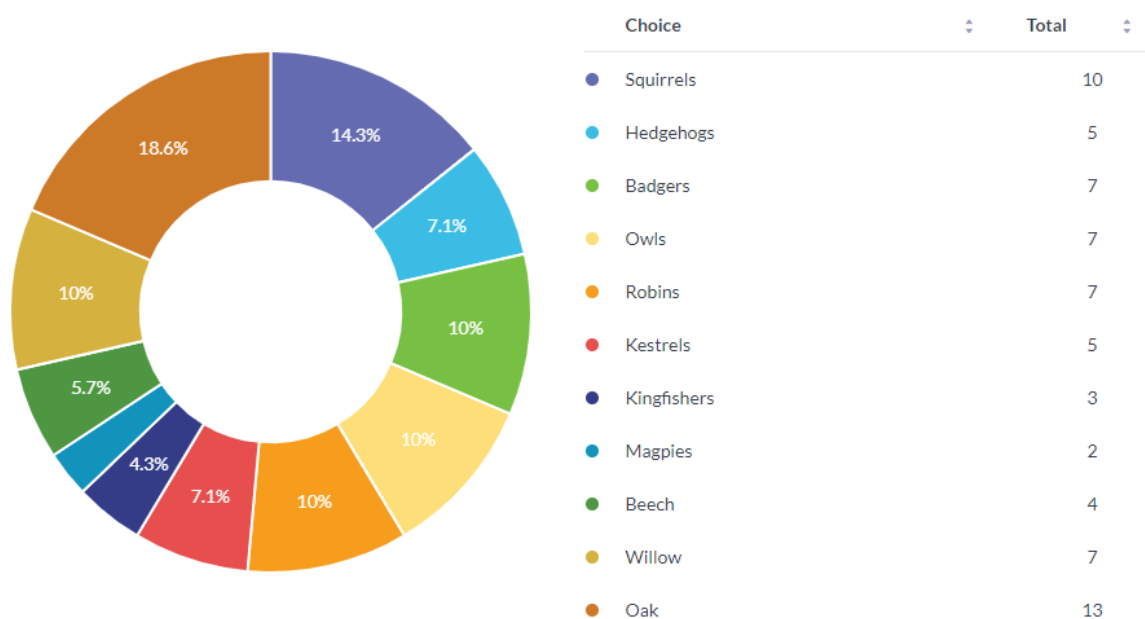


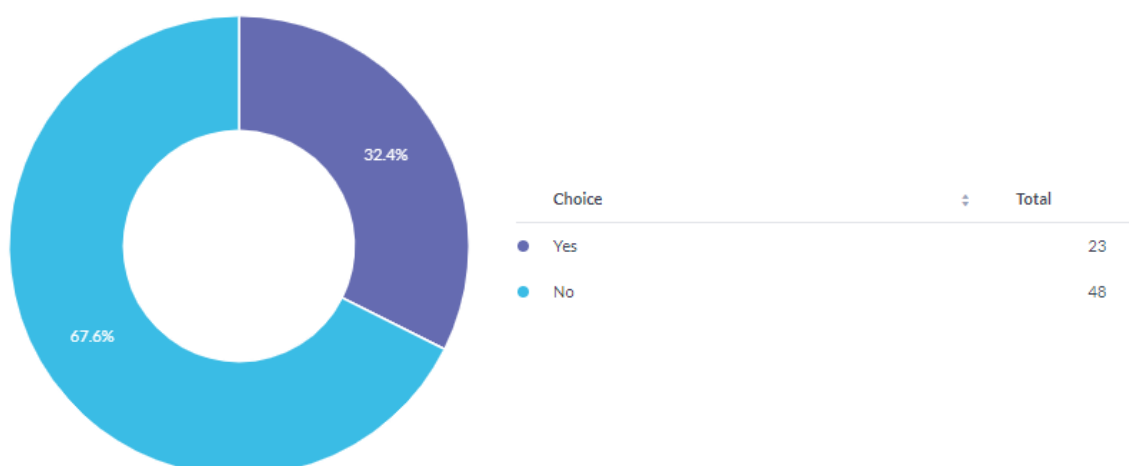
The Woodlands Academy

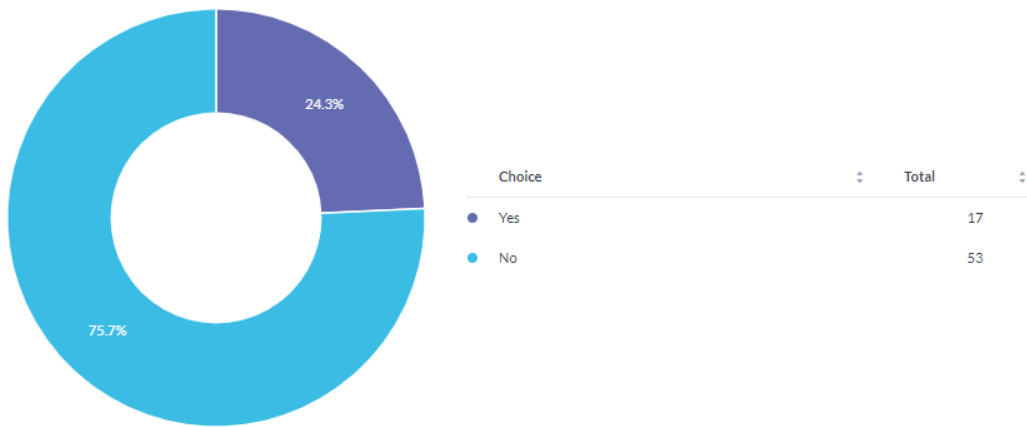
What class group does your child attend?



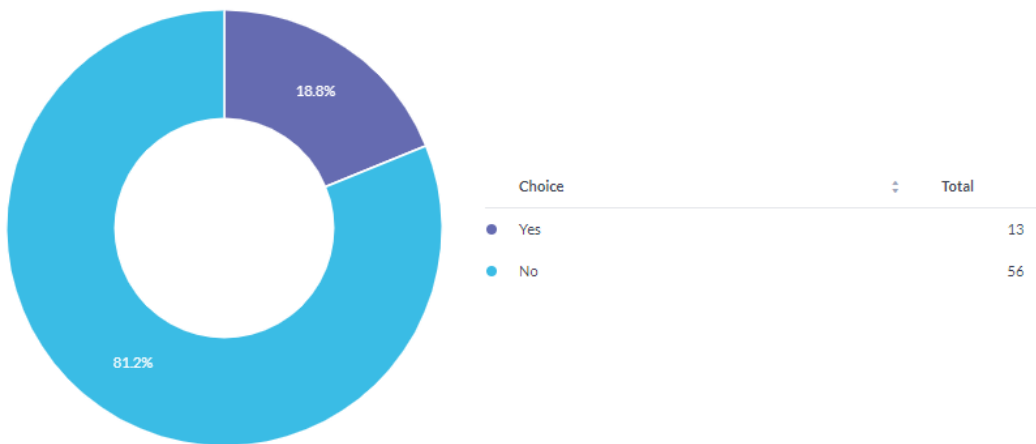
Are you or someone in your home classed as a critical key worker as defined by government?



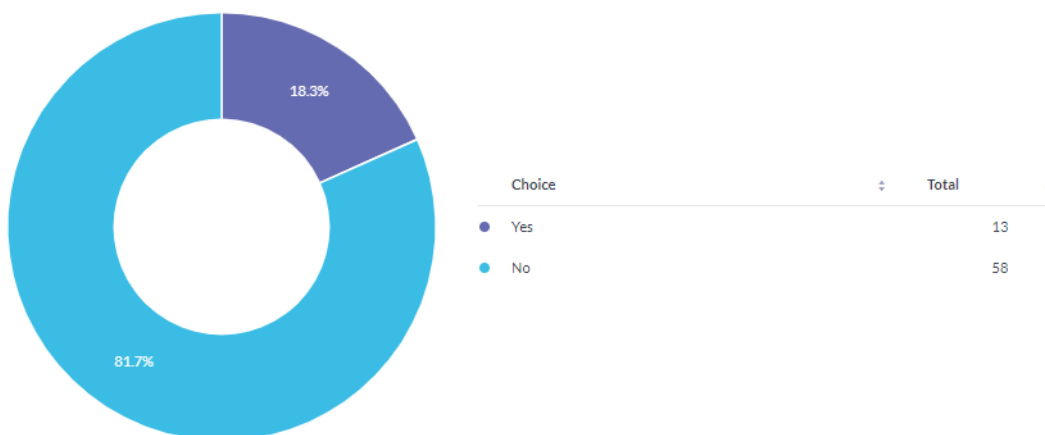
Are you required to return to work as part of the phase one category?



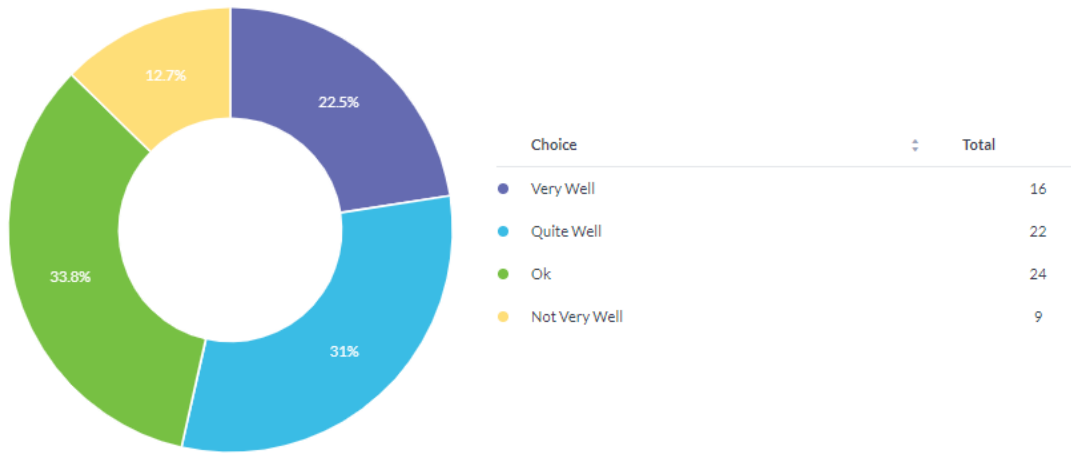
Are you or someone in your household classed as extremely clinically vulnerable?



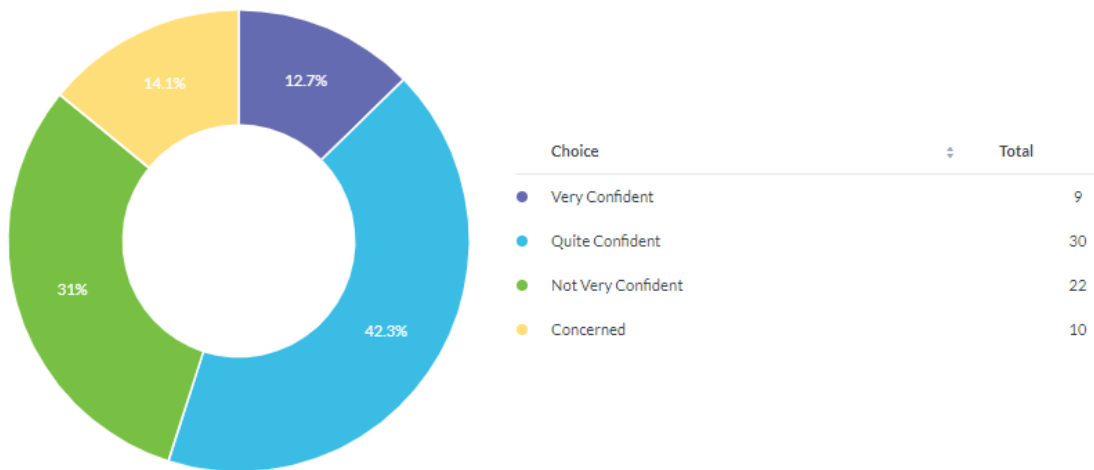
Are you or someone in your household currently shielding?



How well are you coping with the current lockdown measures and your child being at home?

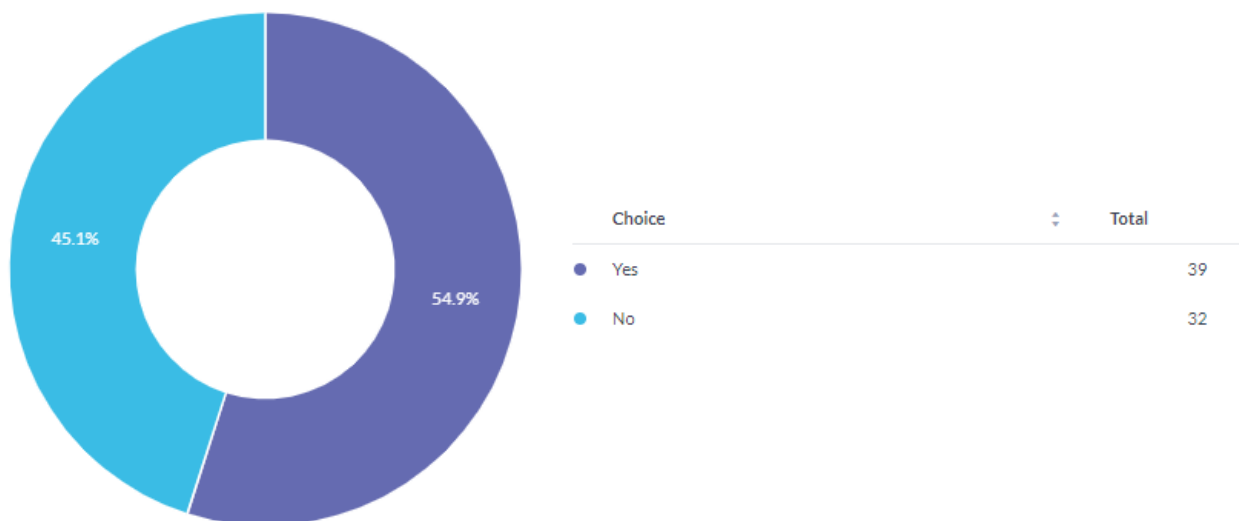


How confident do you feel supporting your child's education and learning?

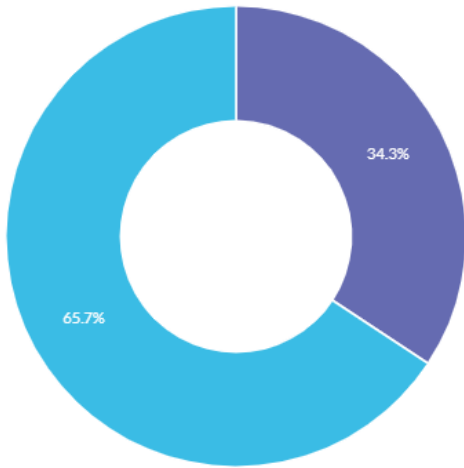

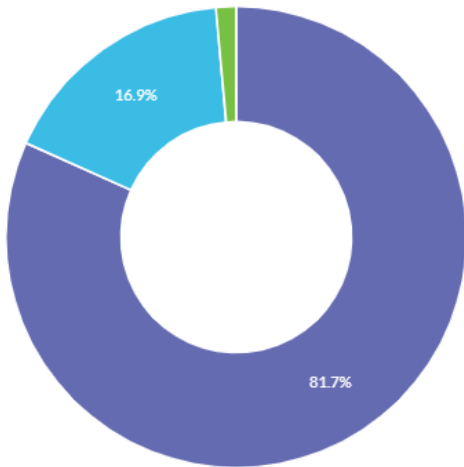

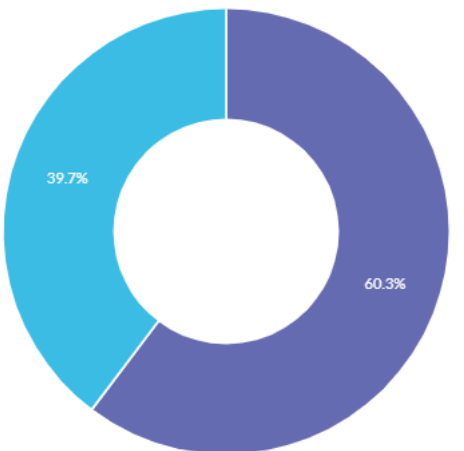

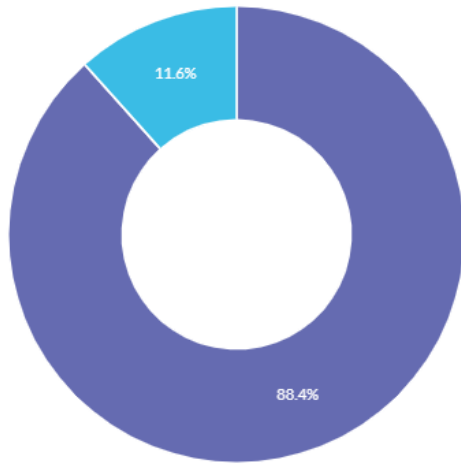

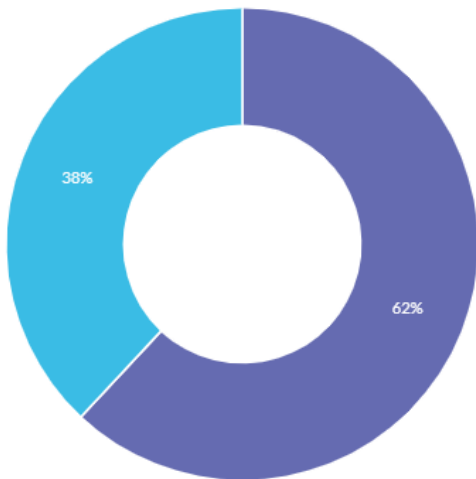

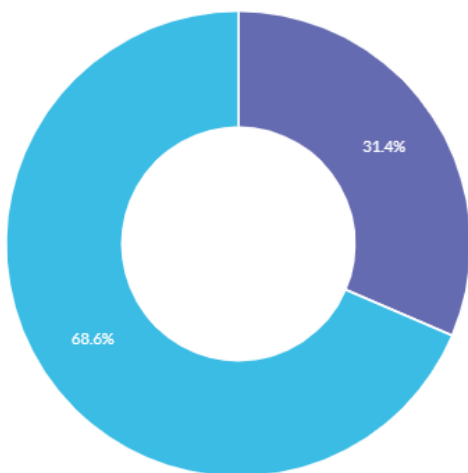

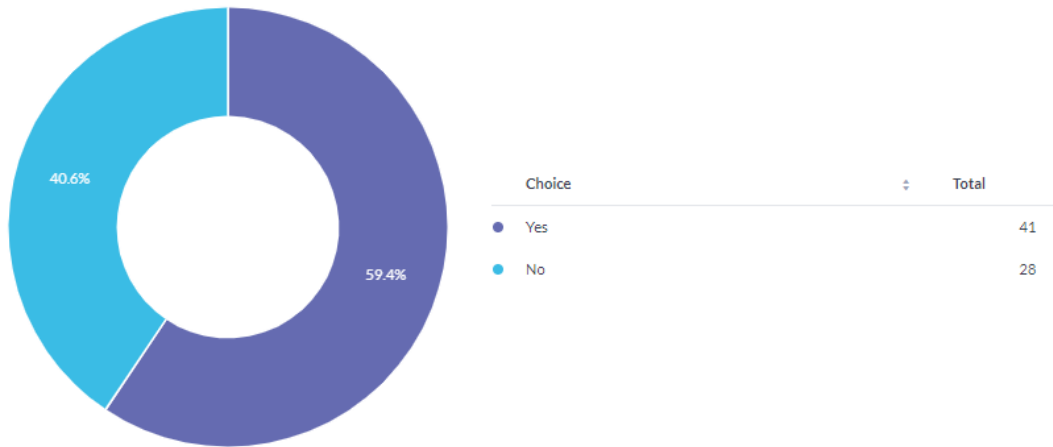

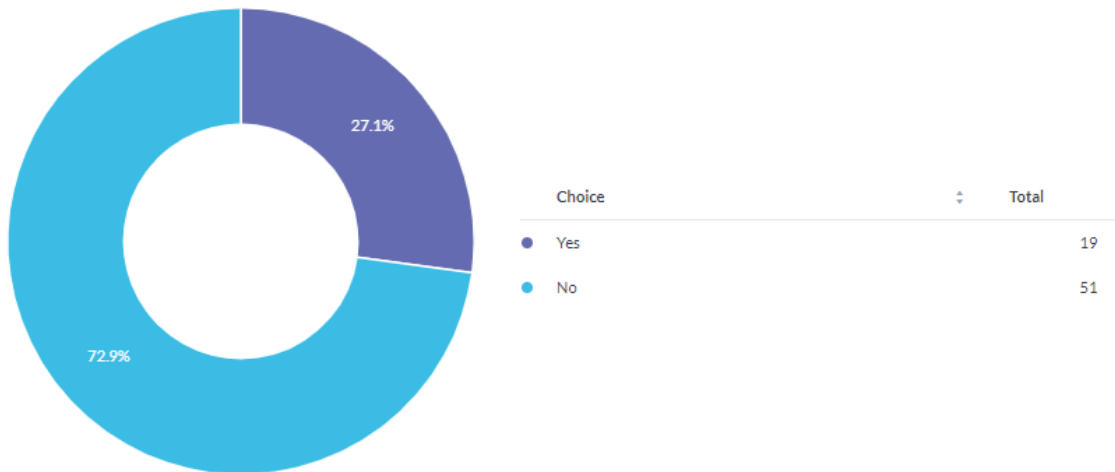

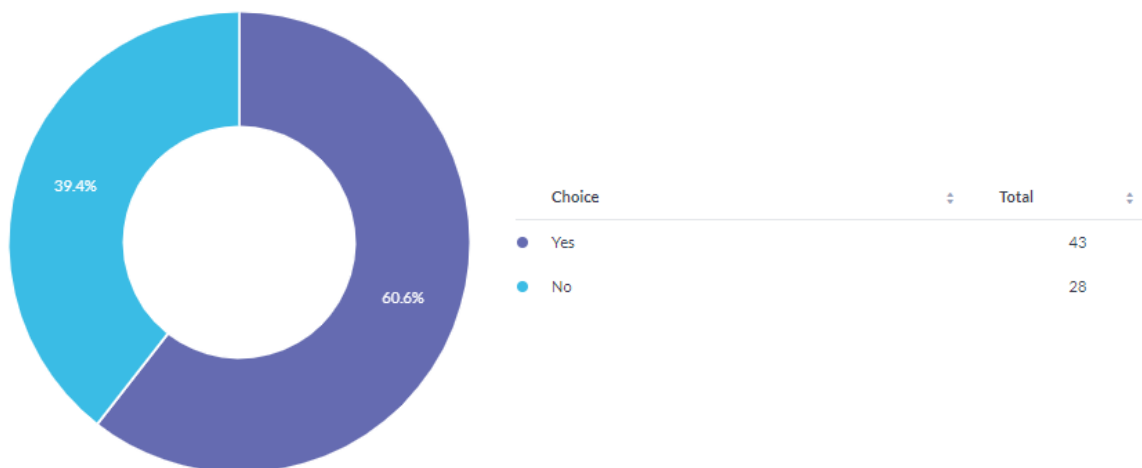
Are you concerned your child may get frustrated with others if they can't/don't abide by social distancing measures?



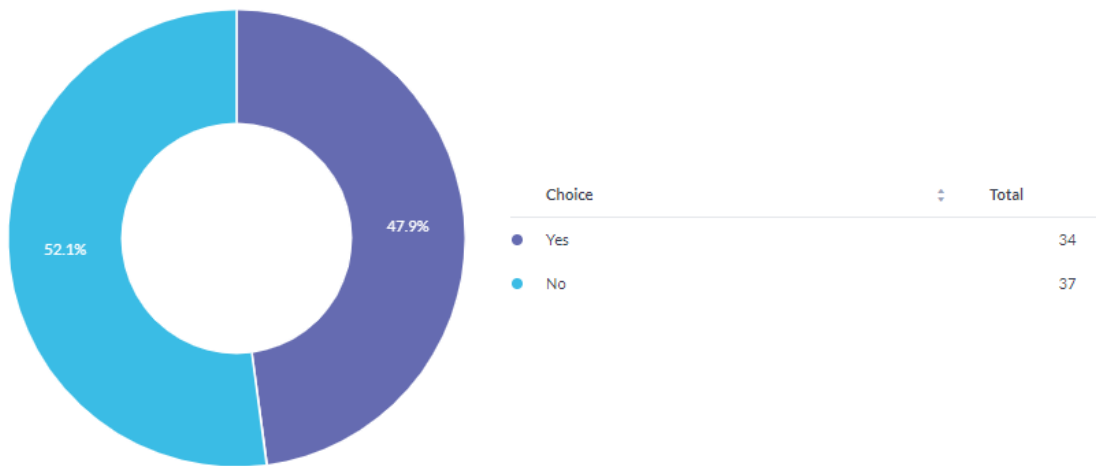
Are you concerned that school may not be able to offer a full time structured routine and consistent approach to learning?



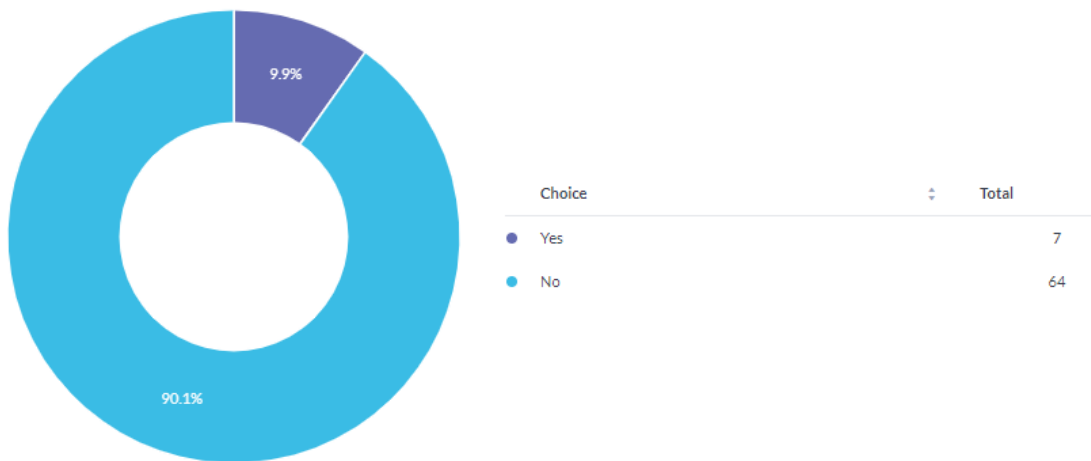
Are you concerned that school may look, feel different and your child may be supported by less familiar staff in a different class group?



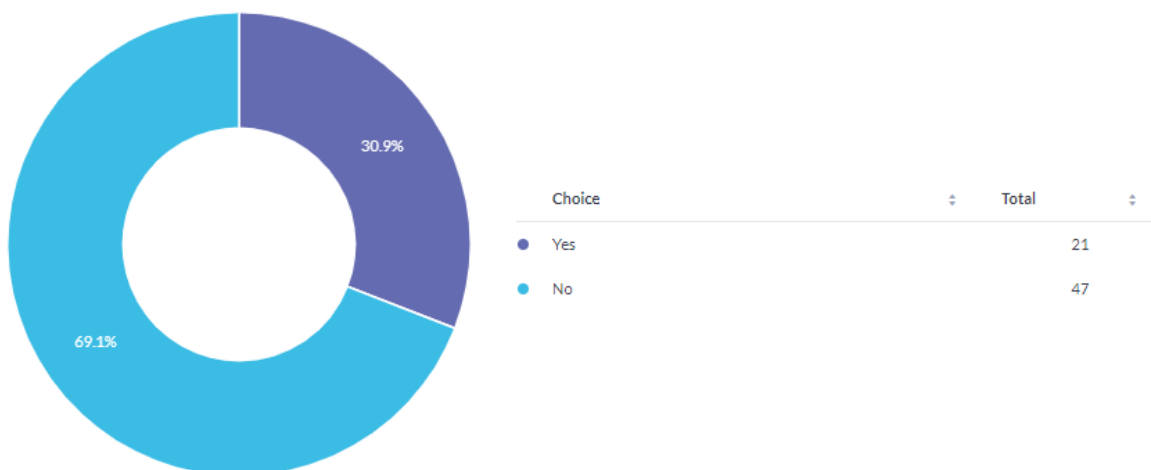
Are you concerned about the Local Authority provided transport adhering to government guidance and minimising risks?



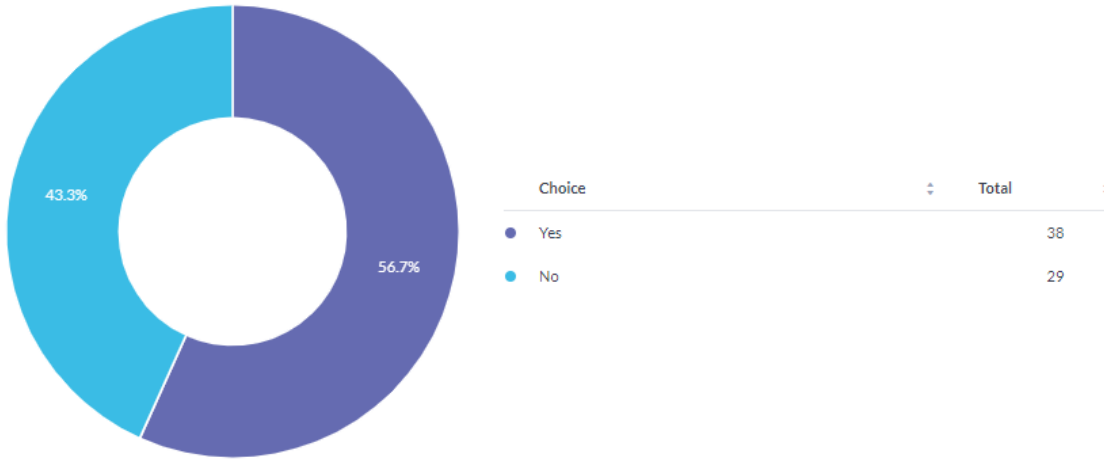
Are you concerned with the school's hygiene and cleaning regime?



Are you concerned about the use of PPE in schools in line with guidance from the government (face masks only to be worn if a child is symptomatic or during intimate personal hygiene care)?



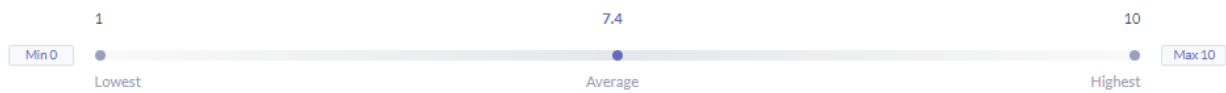
If face masks were compulsory and provided would you consider a place if invited for your child to attend school?



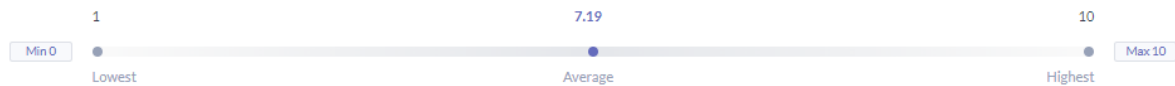
How concerned are you on a scale of 1-5 about your child missing social opportunities?



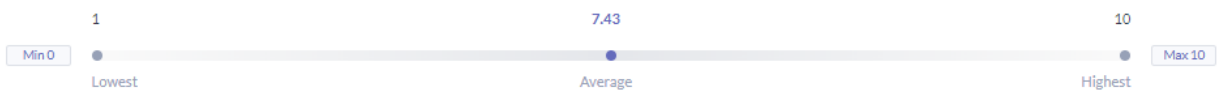
How concerned are you on a scale of 1-10 about your child missing learning opportunities in school?



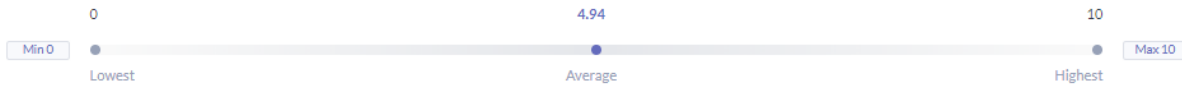
How concerned are you on a scale of 1-10 about your family catching the virus and becoming ill?



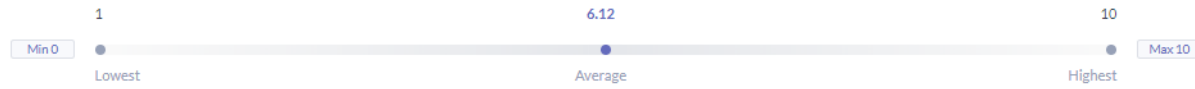
How concerned are you on a scale of 1-10 about the virus impacting on your child's mental health?



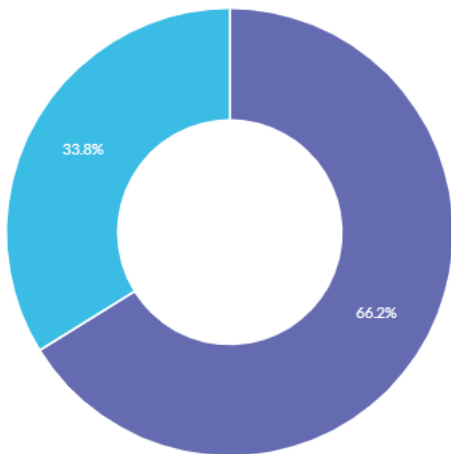
How concerned are you on a scale of 1-10 about having to juggle work and child care/home learning commitments?



How concerned are you on a scale of 1-10 about your child’s transition back into school?

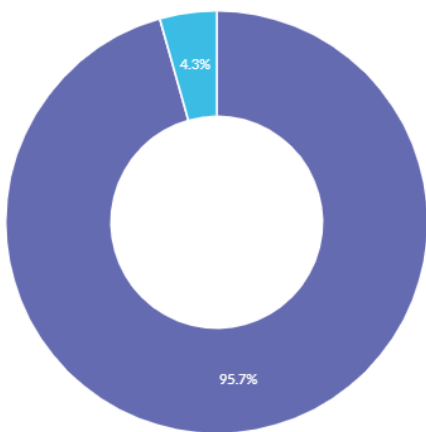


If a part time place (one or two days a week) was identified to support your child to come back nto school from june 1st would you accept it?
